SUBJECT: LTP – Fiscal Year (FY) 2007 Conservation Security Program (CSP) Updated Timeline for Making Participant Payments

Purpose: To provide information to Area and Field level employees on the timeframe for making producers' CSP FY 2007 Continuing Resolution Limit Payments (CRLP).

Expiration Date: September 30, 2007

Action Required by:
Begin Immediately and Complete by June 15, 2007

Background: This bulletin provides Indiana Policy and delivers actions needed from National Bulletin 300-7-19 (copy Attached). NRCS received a second apportionment for CSP and has initiated the second payment period for those participants who received payments affected by the Continuing Resolution Limit (CRL). ProTracts will now add a Continuing Resolution Limit Payment (CRLP) item which will generate on the NRCS-CPA-1245. This CRLP is dependent on available funds and will therefore be prorated to participants based on the total funds received in the CRLP apportionment.

If this CRLP item is the only item to be paid on the NRCS-CPA-1245 generated then the participant will not be required to sign the NRCS-CPA-1245. The following items will be required to make these payments:

- Complete payment instructions
- Print electronically certified NRCS-CPA-1245
- An up-to-date 1199A – For this CRLP payment **ONLY** you may phone verify that there have been no bank changes.
- Complete all other needed items from the Payment Checklist and submit documentation as normal through the Area Program Specialist.

If there are other items to certify on the contract, additional enhancements not already paid or if this is the first payment on this contract for 2007, then the normal payment process must be followed. The participant will be required to sign these NRCS-CPA-1245's and phone verification of the 1199A will not be accepted.
