SUBJECT: CPA – Indiana Amendment of the NFSAM Part 510

Purpose: To transmit the Indiana Amendment 1 of the Title 180 Conservation Planning and Application National Food Security Act Manual Part 510. The attached appeals letter is by policy to be used to deliver all Highly Erodible Lands and/or Wetland Determinations completed in Indiana

Effective Date: Effective Immediately

This amendment revises the Indiana policy on delivering Preliminary Technical Determinations as required by the National Food Security Act Manual (NFSAM). HEL and Wetland Preliminary Wetland determinations must be delivered using the attached document “HEL-WC Preliminary Tech Det Let – Amend 1 180-V-NFSAM Part 510”. This document shall be used for all Preliminary Technical Determinations mailed by Indiana NRCS offices. This letter correctly identifies all appeal rights that are afforded to the USDA participant. The only alterations to this letter which are allowed are those that are available to the user as a fillable form.

This document supersedes and invalidates all other versions of the Preliminary Technical Determination letters issued under previous Indiana Bulletins.
