Sections 7 & 8 -- Conventional and Special Symbols legend ~ Add the following ad hoc
features and definition:

<u>Symbol ID</u>	<u>Name</u>	<u>Description</u>
W 44	Unclassified water	Small, natural or man-made lake, pond, or pit that contains water, of an unspecified nature, most of the year. Typically 0.2 to acres.

WAT and WAT ad hoc features added by the third amendment (12/05/01) are being
reverted to the UWT label by this fourth amendment. A few areas labeled with the M
symbols were large enough to convert to the M-W, miscellaneous water, map unit.
