

CRP MID CONTRACT MANAGEMENT

All new CRP contracts must have mid-term contract management activities scheduled that are site specific, and ensure the plant diversity, wildlife habitat, and protection of soil and water resources. Management activities that ensure these benefits include prescribed burning (according to an approved burn plan), strip disking, strip spraying, and inter-seeding of legumes. All management activities must be performed according to NRCS Standards and Specifications as found in the FOTG, and CRP policy.
