LOCAL LED AND RANKING CRITERIA

Jasper County Local Led and Quality Criteria are based on six resource concerns. Based upon the location of the land and the resource concerns of said land, an applicant may score up to a maximum of 500 points for **Local Quality Criteria** only. In addition to the local quality criteria, an applicant may also score a maximum of 500 points for **State Quality Criteria** also. The following resource concerns and point categories, for Jasper County's Local Quality Criteria, are as follows:

<u>Air Quality</u>	26 points
<u>Erosion</u>	
~Wind Erosion	75 points
~Water Erosion	63 points
<u>Forestry</u>	
~Woodland Terrestrial Species at Risk	31 points
~Forestry	25 points
<u>Impaired Streams and Watersheds</u>	
~Streams	66 points
~Nutrient Impaired Watersheds	49 points
<u>Leaching into the Kankakee River</u>	56 points
<u>Wetlands, Fish, and Plants Impairment</u>	
~Impaired Biotic Communities	45 points
~WRP Buffer	26 points
~Threatened Aquatic Species Watersheds	38 points
 Total Maximum Local Quality Criteria Points=	 500 points
