To be eligible for payment, participant must obtain a farm energy audit by a certified Technical Service Provider for specific recommendations for energy reduction and conservation with estimates of energy savings for the Headquarters area.						
Enterprises (as defined by ASABE S612 Energy Audit Standard) are: Aquaculture, Beef/Veal, Dairy, Field Crops, Fruit/Vegetables, Nursery/Greenhouse, Poultry, and/or Swine.						
Mixed Enterprise is defined as: Typical mixed livestock and non-livestock operation with one non-livestock (Aquaculture, Field Crops, Fruit/Vegetables and/or Nursery/Greenhouse).						
The Mixed Enterprise scenario incorporates up to three non-livestock enterprises with one or more livestock enterprises.						
The mixed enterprise payment is to be multiplied by the number of non-livestock operations (up to three) and added as a component in Protracts to one one of the livestock scenarios.						
For example, a producer has 100 AUs, a Field Crop headquarters and a Vegetable headquarters. The scenario "Livestock - Medium 70-300 AU" would be scheduled PLUS "Mixed Enterprise" for a quantity of 2 as another component in the same CIN.

By definition a CNMP is a conservation plan for confined feeding operations (CFOs).

For EQIP, the CNMP is written/developed for all acres and/or manure owned or under decision-making authority at that CFO (including lands under a "Land Use Agreement" or other similar control of the manure application.)

All manure applications under control of the participant must be included in the CNMP.

If the participant does not have control over all of the land or manure, then the participant is only eligible for the CNMP Non-Cattle Non-Regulated >20 ac, CNMP Cattle Non-Regulated >20 ac, or Non-Regulated (All Livestock) < 20 ac payment rate.

An economic evaluation will be completed to determine the need for a CNMP on small facilities.

All tracts and fields under the CNMP will be included in the Toolkit plan and the Protracts contract.

Participants must use a TechReg TSP to be eligible for payment.

Non-Regulated = small confined animal feeding operation with resource concerns that could be addressed by a CNMP or where the participant does not have control over the manure after it leaves the facility.

Medium (CFO) = confined feeding operation with IDEM Confined Feeding Operations Rule permit.

Large (CAFO) = confined feeding operation with IDEM/EPA Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation permit.

CNMPs must be completed (certified) prior to the design and installation of a cost-shared Waste Storage Facility (313) and Waste Treatment Lagoon (359).

The CNMP must be used as the basis for the design of any waste storage and handling facilities.

Livestock producers not building a 313 or 359 and requesting assistance for a CNMP **are** eligible for the CNMP Conservation Activity Plan.

Non-Livestock producers receiving manure from another farm **are not** eligible for the CNMP Conservation Activity Plan.

However if a non- livestock producer has a contract to receive manure at the site for the length of the EQIP contract **and** is building a Waste Storage Facility (313) or Waste Treatment Lagoon (359), then a CNMP is required and the participant **would be** eligible for payment.

Participants that are required to develop a CNMP must be informed of the CNMP requirements.
