



## Wireless Data Transfer with an Oregon 550(t) Unit

### **Abstract**

This guide outlines the steps to transfer a single feature wirelessly between two Oregon 550(t) GPS units. Only one feature at a time can be transferred to one listening unit at a time.

*Steps Send: Press Share Wirelessly – Press Send – Select Feature Type – Select Feature – Press Send*

*Steps Receive: Press Share Wirelessly – Press Receive*

### **Details**

The GPS units do not need to have a satellite fix when transferring data.

#### *Send*

1. **Press Share Wirelessly.**




2. **Press Send. Select** the feature type to be sent. **Select** a feature to be sent.






- The unit will display the selected feature to send on the map screen. Press **Send**.



- The unit will display a message that it is connecting to another GPS unit and when it finds one, it will display a progress bar as it sends the data. When finished, the unit will display a transfer complete message. Data can only be sent to one other GPS unit at a time.



- Once data is sent, go back through the menus to send more data or exit back to the Main Menus.



Receive


1. Press **Share Wirelessly**.



2. Press **Receive**.



3. The unit will display a message that it is listening for another GPS unit to begin sending data. When a connection with a sending unit is established the unit will display a progress bar as the data transfers. When finished, the unit will display a transfer complete message.



4. Go back through the menus to receive more data or exit the Share Wirelessly feature.
