




Base Camp Overview

Abstract

This guide outlines basic features of Base Camp and its commonly used tools and functions. It shows the typical appearance of Base Camp following initial setup and while an Oregon GPS unit is connected.

This page illustrates the tools and features of the Base Camp application. The following page describes each tool or feature in greater detail. The toolbars in Base Camp must remain docked in the grey area at the top, but can be rearranged within that area.

Menus	The main menus in Base Camp. Many functions and options are accessible via these menus.
Swap Map/Data Views button	This button will swap the position of the map display frame and the list of data objects (waypoints, tracks, etc...).
Map Product Selector dropdown	Allows the user to change the currently displayed base map if other maps are available. The only two active options for IN NRCS should be Global Map or Topo US 100k, if the Oregon GPS with Topo data is connected.
View 2D Map button	Sets the map frame to display a typical 2D map.
Overview Map button	Turns the Overview Map frame on or off.
Pan tool	Used to pan and rotate the map. With this tool active click and drag the map to pan. Right-click and drag the map to rotate. To reset rotation to north, click <i>View > Align North Up</i> from the menus.
Zoom tool	Used to zoom on the map when active. Click to zoom in. Right-click to zoom out. Click, hold, drag and release to zoom in on a user defined box extent.
Select tool	Used to select data object features on the map such as waypoints, tracks, etc...and then view the object's properties.
Library and Devices frame	Displays any lists stored in your collection. A list is a group of data objects the user has created and can be thought of as a file containing a specific subset of data. Lists are used to export files that contain sets or subsets of data. Any connected devices and their contents are also displayed here. Click any of the items in this area to have their contents displayed in the Data Objects frame and on the map (if applicable).
Map Display frame	Displays the base map and objects from currently selected list or device.
North Arrow	True north. Rotates with the map if the map is rotated.
Overview Map Display frame	A smaller scale view of the current map frame location.
Adjustable Frame bar	Click, hold, and drag to adjust the visible areas of the Library/Devices frame and the Data Objects frame.
Data Objects frame	Displays the waypoints, tracks, etc... of the currently selected list or device.
Data Objects Search Dropdown	Allows user to type names of data objects to be searched. The map will pan to and select and hits from the search.
Alt Swap Map/Data Views button	This button will swap the position of the map display frame and the list of data objects (waypoints, tracks, etc...).
